







KinderConnect – Meaning of Colors and Symbols on the Attendance Detail Screen

Colors on Attendance Days:

<p>Red: Indicates an invalid time pair. Example: The Out time is earlier than the In time.</p>	
<p>Yellow: Indicates missing time. Either the In time or Out time is missing.</p>	
<p>Dark Gray: Attendance can no longer be entered/backdated/edited.</p>	
<p>Green: Attendance has been submitted to DES. No further corrections can be made.</p>	

Symbols and Indicators:

<p>Blank Cells: There is no schedule authorization for that time period.</p>	
<p>Blue “S” (Sponsor Indicator): A blue “S” appears next to the In/Out time field when attendance was entered or last updated by any Sponsor (parent). Note: This indicator appears only when the Shows Sponsor Records (S) checkbox is checked.</p>	
<p>Green Check Mark (Approval Indicator): A green check mark appears when attendance has been approved OR entered by the primary sponsor (parent).</p>
